RELIEVING PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Dear Families,

Welcome to Week 6! Updated Covid guidelines mean that we can resume many of our planned activities onsite. However, at this stage parent and community involvement is still very limited. Updated Level 3 Covid guidelines

Assemblies and presentations

Assemblies and presentations will be allowed outdoors on site. Fully vaccinated visitors (including parents and carers) are only allowed to attend if completing a specific role (such as presenting) and at the invitation of the school. All visitors must check in using the school check in and show proof of vaccination.

Dancing, singing, music and performances

Dancing will be allowed indoors and outdoors in class cohorts.

Bands, ensembles, music classes and music tuition will be allowed within cohorts and only for instruments that do not rely on breath, as these pose a higher transmission risk.

School performances, productions and concerts are not permitted.

Parking Rules

Please park safely and legally on the streets around your school. Park legally so you do not incur parking fines and demerit points. Council's Traffic Compliance Officers enforce parking around schools. If you park contrary to the road rules you will be fined!

You cannot stop or park your vehicle:



Within 10m of an intersecting road at an intersection without traffic lights (20m with traffic lights), unless a sign states you can park there (see image at left).

ENALTIES FROM: \$464 erit Points apply in School Zone



Within 20m before and 10m after a bus stop (see image)

Useful driver tips

- Lights flash on buses to warn motorists that buses are picking up and dropping off passengers (often school children)
- Slow down to 40km/h when overtaking or passing a bus displaying flashing lights
- A driver can help keep children safe by:




