I write to provide you an update on the permanent Principal position at Arcadia Public School.

A full Department of Education Merit Selection process has now been finalised. This has involved a five person panel with myself as Panel Convenor as the Director along with staff, community, principal and AECG representatives as part of the process.

The full process has now been completed which involved written applications, shortlisting processes, interviews and referees. I am absolutely delighted to advise that the successful candidate for the role of Principal of Arcadia Public School is Ms Nicole Pattison, current relieving Principal of Arcadia Public School, who is substantively Assistant Principal of Niagara Park Public School. This will be pending the normal 10 day appeal period of the process.

Check-In-Assessment

The Check-in assessment is an online reading and numeracy assessment for students in Years 3 to 9. Our Year 4 and Year 6 students completed the Check -in-Assessment in Term 1 and, overall, our results were very pleasing. Year 6 Numeracy was 81.5% compared to 68% for similar schools and Reading

Nicole permanently to Arcadia Public School and to Year 4 Reading was 57.4% compared to 55.7% similar schools and Numeracy was 60.9% compared I look forward to working with Nicole and the team to 60.2% for similar schools. Arcadia Public School Students will be participating in the 2022 NSW Premier's Reading Challenge. Years 3-6 will be doing this as they did last year. The children can then add to their reading logs at any time. Years K-2 will have their reading Logs completed by Mrs Feely our PRC Coordinator.

The Challenge aims to encourage a love of reading for leisure and pleasure in students, and to enable them to experience quality literature. It is not a competition but a challenge to each student to read, to read more and to read more widely

Some easy to follow instructions are below to remind students how to access the PRC.

Students are required to login to their Student Portal (this can be done from your home computer as well as your child's school computer)

In the search menu type in Premiers Reading Challenge


